

# SWINGERS



## MATERIALS

- 2" (5.1 cm) of sterling silver 20-gauge dead-soft wire
- 2" (5.1 cm) of sterling silver 24-gauge dead-soft wire
- 2 blue/yellow 12mm lampworked glass beads
- 2 blue quartz 7mm faceted rondelles
- 1 pair sterling silver ear wires

## TOOLS

- Flush cutters
- Chain-nose pliers
- Round-nose pliers

## FINISHED SIZE

1½" (3.8 cm)

1. Cut the 20-gauge wire in half. Cut the 24-gauge wire in half and make 2 head pins.
2. Use 1 head pin to string 1 blue quartz rondelle. Form a wrapped loop.
3. Use one 20-gauge wire to form a simple loop. String 1 lampworked glass bead. Form a simple loop that attaches to the wrapped loop formed in Step 2.
4. Attach 1 ear wire to the other simple loop.
5. Repeat Steps 2 to 4 for the second earring.
