

# RINGS OF GLASS



## MATERIALS

4" (10.2 cm) of sterling silver 20-gauge half-hard wire

2 teal 15mm glass rings

## TOOLS

Flush cutters

Round-nose pliers

File or wire smoother

Sharpie

## FINISHED SIZE

1⅞" (2.9 cm)

1. Cut the wire in half.
2. Use round-nose pliers in the middle of the jaw to make a simple loop on one end of 1 wire.
3. Use the Sharpie to shape an ear wire. Use the file to smooth the end.
4. Attach the loop to 1 glass ring.
5. Repeat Steps 2 to 4 for the second earring.

**Alternative:** Hang hammered closed jump rings for an everyday earring.
