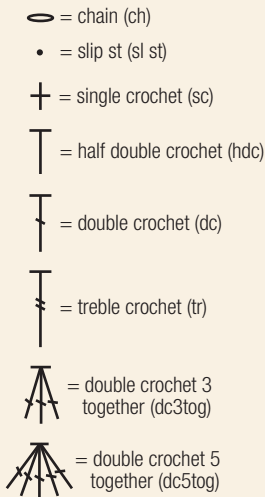
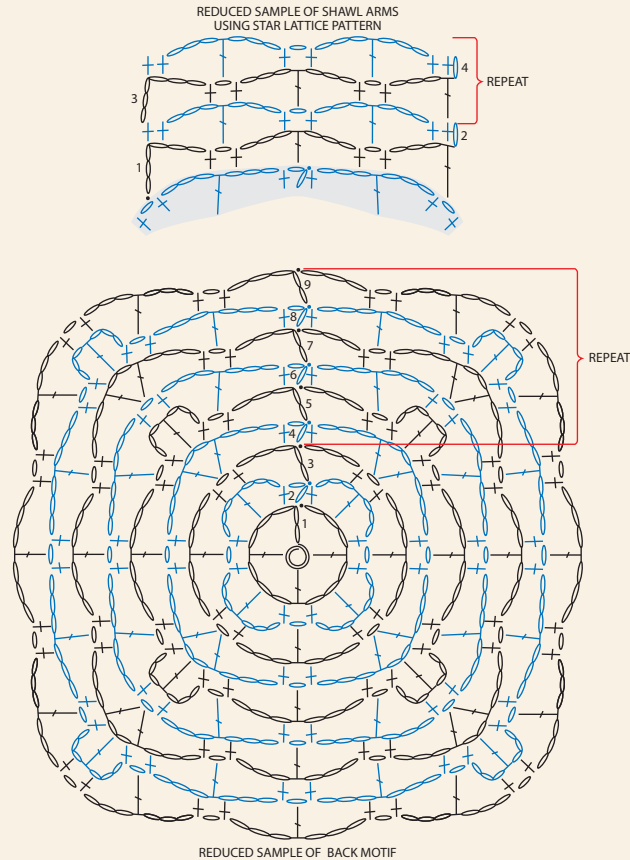


STITCH KEY



BACK MOTIF/SHAWL ARMS



1, (sc-ch 3-dc-ch 3-sc) in ch-2 sp of next V-st, *ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1 (sc-ch 3-dc-ch 3-sc) in next ch-2 sp of next V-st; rep from * twice, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, join with sl st in first sc, turn—24 ch-3 sps; 12 ch-sps.

Rnd 9: Ch 5, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in next 3-ch sp, ch 1, sc in next 3-ch sp, *ch 3, dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in

next ch-3 sp; rep from * twice, ch 3, dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in next 3-ch sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, join with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch-5, turn.—24 ch-3 sps; 12 ch-sps.

Rnds 10-21: Rep Rnds 4-9 twice, accommodating longer repeats of the stitch pattern along the sides of the increasing motif. You will “dc in next ch-sp” or “sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in next 3-ch sp” as appropriate.

Rnd 22-24: Rep Rnds 4-6 once more.—64 ch-3 sps; 32 ch-1 sps.

Shawl Arms

Refer to the Back Motif/Shawl Arms

diagram above for assistance.

First Arm

Row 1: (WS) Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3 here and throughout), sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp, *ch 3, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from * 15 times, ending with last dc in next corner ch-1 sp, turn—16 ch-3 sps; 8 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: (RS) Ch 1, sc in first dc, sc in next ch-3 sp, *ch 3, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, *ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in 3rd ch of ch-6 tch, turn—16 ch-3 sps; 7 ch-1 sps.

Rows 3-80: Work even in Star Lattice
