



# innisfree

Granny stripes get a creative makeover in this casual wrap perfect to wear for drinks at a café after a poetry reading. If color makes your heart beat faster, you'll enjoy the painterly technique of blending two yarns to create a gradient of color, and it will open up new worlds for your crochet and your approach to colorwork. Innisfree uses the idea of a color wash worked sideways, and each new color is worked for twice as many rows as the previous color. The V-stitch and chain-loop border highlights the effect of color drizzling like paints running off a canvas. Experiment with thread tones to get your favorite progression. Your color options are limitless!

## FINISHED SIZE

About 75" (190.5 cm) wide × 33" (84 cm) deep at center.

## YARN

Size 10 crochet thread (#0 Lace Weight).

**Shown here:** Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet Thread Size 10 (100% mercerized cotton; 350 yd [320 m]): #458 Purple (A), 4 balls; #856 Peacock (B), 3 balls; #805 Blue Hawaii (C), 3 balls.

## HOOK

Size G/6 (4.0 mm).

## NOTIONS

Tapestry needle.

## GAUGE

20 sts × 9 rows = 4" (10 cm) in shawl body pattern.
