

## Border (worked across lower two edges of the triangle)

Refer to the Shawl Body/Border diagram for assistance.

**Row 1:** (RS) Ch 5, (hdc, dtr) in next ch-2 sp, bp-hdc around the post of next st, \*fp-dtr around the post of next st, bp-hdc around the post of next st\*; rep from \* to \* across to next ch-2 sp, (dtr, hdc) in next ch-2 sp, (fp-dtr, bp-hdc, fp-dtr) around the post of next st (pm in center bp-hdc and move marker up as work progresses), (hdc, dtr) in next ch-2 sp, bp-hdc over next st; rep from \* to \* across to last ch-5 sp, (dtr, hdc, ch 2, dc) in last ch-5 sp, turn.

**Row 2:** (WS) Ch 5, (hdc, dtr), in next ch-2 sp, bp-hdc around the post of next st, \*fp-dtr around the post of next st, bp-hdc around the post of next st\*, rep from \* to \* across to marked center st, (bp-hdc, fp-dtr,

bp-hdc) around post of center st; rep from \* to \* across to last ch-5 sp, (dtr, hdc, ch 2, dc) in last ch-5 sp, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 5, (hdc, dtr) in next ch-2 sp, bp-hdc around the post of next st, \*fp-dtr over next st, bp-hdc over next st\* rep from \* to \* across to marked center st, (fp-dtr, bp hdc, fp-dtr) around the post of center st, bp-hdc around post of next st; rep from \* to \* across to next ch-5 sp, (dtr, hdc, ch 2, dc) in last ch-5 sp, turn.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 three times. Do not turn at end of last row.

## Edging

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), working in row-end sts across long edge of shawl, \*2 hdc in next row-end st, hdc in next row-end st; rep from \* across to next corner ch-5 sp, 5 hdc in next ch-5 sp, hdc in each

st to center st of lower point, 3 dc in center st of lower point, hdc in each st across to next ch-2 sp, 2 hdc in last ch-2 sp, join with sl st in top of beg ch-2.

Fasten off, leaving a 6" (15 cm) tail.

## Finishing

Weave in ends. Wet-block the shawl and spread out to dry, steaming to relax any curl. This yarn drapes beautifully with steaming.
