

Press the seams toward piece X. Trim each unit to $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm) with a $\frac{1}{4}''$ (6 mm) seam allowance on piece W. You will have six large quarter-circle units.

- 4** Refer to **Figure 2** and **Figure 3** to assemble the small butterfly units. Sew a blue print square $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ (9 x 9 cm) to one wing unit. Press the seam toward the blue print square. Sew the remaining wing unit to the body unit. Press the seam toward the wing fabrics. Sew the two pieces together, matching the center seams. Press the seam open. Make a total of eleven small butterfly units.
- 5** Refer to **Figure 2** and **Figure 3** to assemble the medium butterfly units. Sew a blue print square $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$ (14 x 14 cm) to one wing unit. Press the seam toward the blue print square. Sew the remaining wing unit to the body unit. Press the seam toward the wing fabrics. Sew the two pieces together, matching the center seams. Press the seam open. Make a total of four medium butterfly units.
- 6** Refer to **Figure 2** and **Figure 3** to assemble the large butterfly blocks. Sew a blue print square $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm) to one wing unit. Press the seam toward the blue print square. Sew the remaining wing unit to the body unit. Press the seam toward the wing fabrics. Sew the two pieces together, matching the center seams. Press the seam open. Make a total of two large butterfly blocks.

SMALL BUTTERFLY BLOCKS

Refer to the Butterflies Construction Diagram (page 60) to correctly orient placement of the butterflies. There are four variations of the block made with small butterflies.

- 1** For Small Butterfly Block #1, make two blocks with purple print butterflies and one with an orange print butterfly. For each block, sew together two blue print squares $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm). Press the seam to the right. Sew a blue print square $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm) to an MN unit with fabric #1 in the bottom right corner. Press the seam to the left. Sew together

the top and bottom units, matching center seams (**fig. 4**). Press the seam open.

- 2** For Small Butterfly Block #2, make three blocks with purple print butterflies. For each block, sew an MN unit with fabric #1 in the bottom right corner to a blue square $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm). Press the seam to the right. Sew together two blue print squares $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm). Press the seam to the left. Sew together the top and bottom units, matching center seams (**fig. 5**). Press the seam open.
- 3** For Small Butterfly Block #3, make one block with an orange print butterfly. Sew together two blue print squares $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm). Press the seam to the left. Sew an MN unit with fabric #1 in the bottom left corner to a blue print square $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm). Press the seam to the right. Sew together the top and bottom units, matching center seams (**fig. 6**). Press the seam open.
- 4** For Small Butterfly Block #4, make two blocks with one yellow print butterfly and one pink print butterfly. For each block, sew an MN unit with fabric #1 in the top left corner to a blue square $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm). Press the seam to the right. Sew a blue print square $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ (16.5 x 16.5 cm) to an MN block with fabric #1 in the bottom right corner. Press the seam to the left. Sew together the top and bottom units, matching center seams (**fig. 7**). Press the seam open.

MEDIUM BUTTERFLY BLOCKS

Make four blocks.

- 1** For each block, sew a blue print strip $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{2}''$ (6.5 x 26.5 cm) to the top of a YZ block with fabric #1 in the bottom right corner (**fig. 8**). Press the seam toward the strip.
- 2** Sew a blue print strip $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$ (6.5 x 31.5 cm) to the left side (**fig. 9**). Press the seam toward the strip. You will have two yellow print and two orange print blocks.
